 - ✓ Continuous input from field practitioners

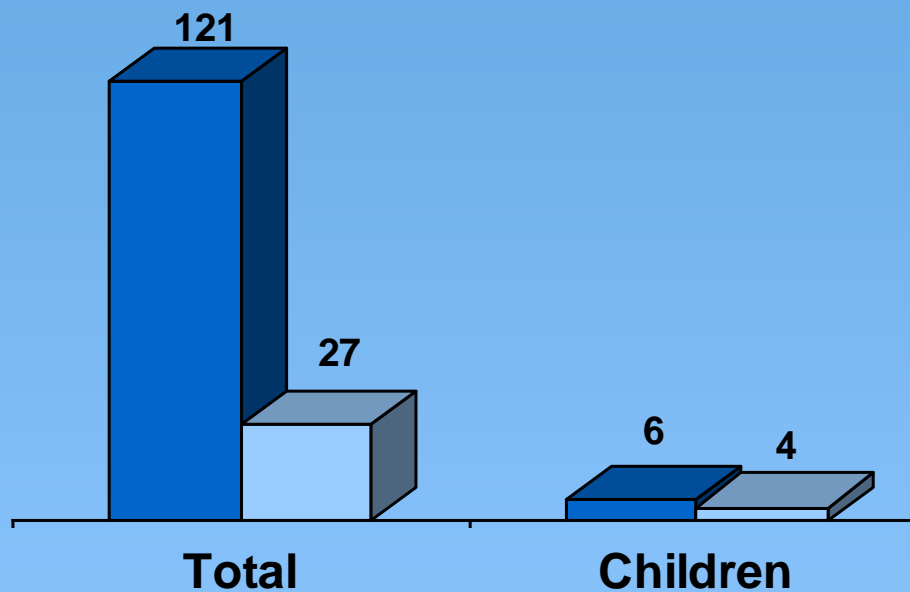
**ANITP' role in repatriation and assistance
of trafficking victims**

- National contact point for transnational referral of adult victims
- Coordinates the assisted repatriation of victims
- Facilitates victim's access to specialised services
- Monitors the victim's assistance
- Supports the victims during criminal proceedings

Transnational referrals and assisted repatriations of trafficking victims in 2013

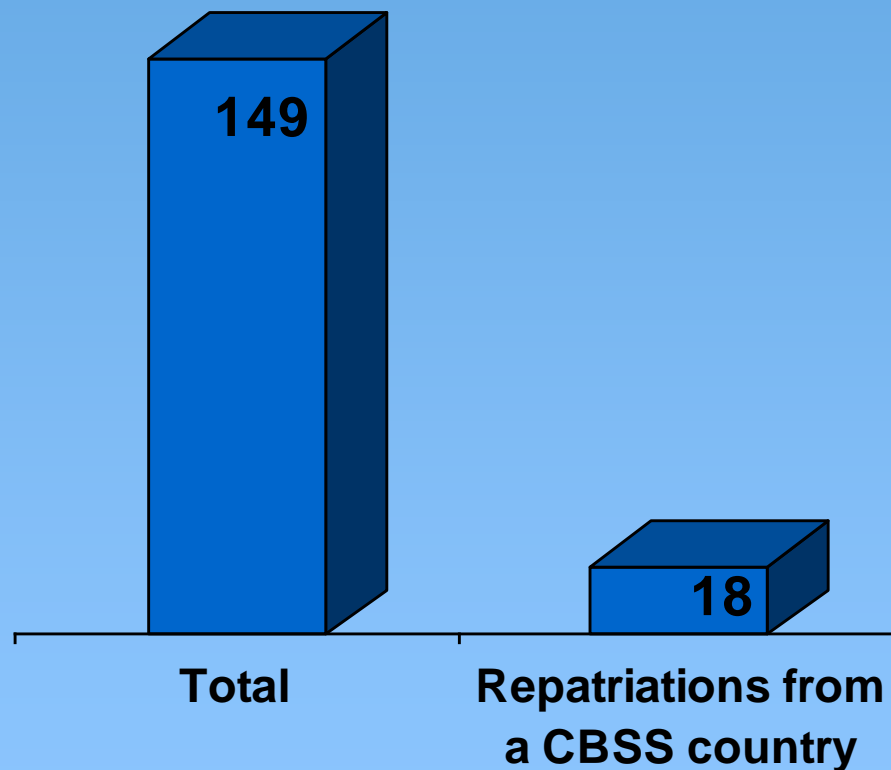


■ Total □ Repatriations from a CBSS country

Challenges in assisting children victims of trafficking

- Disparities and lacks in organization and functioning of specialized services for the protection and assistance of children.
- Children's age: about 90% of annually identified children are aged between 14 and 17, mostly 17 years old.

**Ongoing projects to improve the quality of
assistance and protection for victims of
trafficking including children**

- Detailed evaluation of specialised services for victims
- Review of the institutional and legal framework for victims assistance
- Joint coordination of SOP development and implementation on both levels, central and local

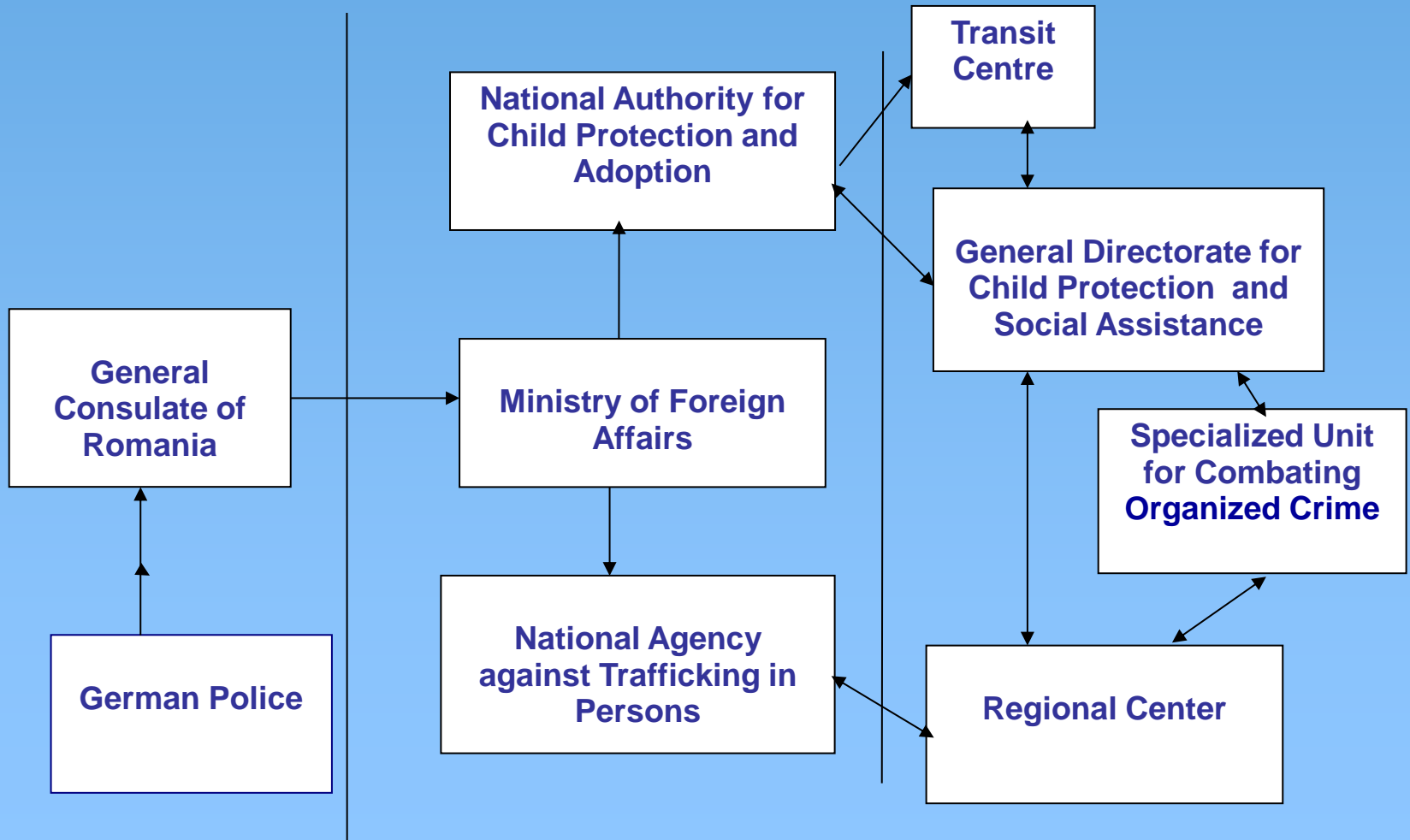
